Curriculum organisation information for families following COVID19 for Autumn Term 1 2020


Weeks 1-2



Personal, Social and Health Education and Wellbeing focus

The children will be welcomed back into school and helped to settle into the expectations of school life. 'Exploration Fortnight'

The purpose of Exploration Fortnight is to gradually introduce the children to the core subjects of Reading, Writing and Maths whilst understanding where there may be gaps in their knowledge. This will be done in a sensitive and child friendly way.

The teachers will be working alongside the children during these two weeks to talk to them and assess where they are in relation to their learning.

Many of our children will return with new skills that they have developed as a result of lockdown and it is important that these are explored and noted during this time.

All of this information will help to shape the learning journey that each child will need to follow.


Every child is unique. Strengths will be celebrated and areas for development will be planned for and supported.
