**Year 3/4**

Write the words YAPTON SCHOOL vertically down the side of your page. **Can you write your own acrostic poem using each letter as the beginning of your line?** For example:

You always feel welcome at school  
 All the children at Yapton are kind to each other  
 People always comment on how polite we are  
 THINK helps us to make the right choices

**Can you write another acrostic poem about a member of your family or one of your friends?**

**Year 3/4**

Draw a map for your dream school. **What would be the length and width of each classroom in your dream school? Can you create a timetable of your dream school day?**

Create your dream school using junk modelling materials. **Which 3d shapes have you used to create your dream school? Can you describe their properties? How many edges, faces and vertices does each 3d shape have?**



**Year 3/4**

Explore the nature that you can find in Yapton. Can you spot and identify plants, trees and creatures that live in Yapton? What makes Yapton a good place for these plants and animals to live? Create your own information book about Yapton's nature.



**Year 5/6**

Write the words YAPTON SCHOOL vertically down the side of your page. **Can you write your own acrostic poem using each letter as the beginning of your line?** For another challenge, write another poem about Yapton School. **Could you write a calligram in the shape of our school badge, a kenning or a poem that rhymes?**



**Year 5/6**

Design your dream school and draw a map. **Can you label the length and width of each room? What would each room's perimeter and area be? Can you work out the perimeter and area of the whole school?**

Build your dream school using junk modelling materials. **How can you describe the properties of the 3d shapes you've used?** Create a poster that describes the 3d shapes – including information about their faces, vertices and edges. **Challenge: Can you work out the volume of the cubes and cuboid shapes that you have used?**

**Year 5/6**

Explore the nature that you can find in Yapton. Sketch and label the plants, trees and animals that you find. Why is the village a good habitat for them? Classify the trees and plants that you find using a classification key like the example above.

### Get Arty!

If you could design your dream school, what would it look like? What lessons would there be? What play equipment would you have? Would you have a swimming pool, skate park or trampoline hall? Draw, paint or build your dream school.

We talk a lot about our Yapton crown, can you design your own Yapton crown? You could even make it and take a picture of yourself wearing it to tweet to your teacher!



Our school badge has a shield on it. Can you create a personal shield that represents what Yapton school means to you?

### History

Can you find out about the history of our school? How long has there been a school in Yapton? Did anyone in your family go to Yapton school when they were young? Can they tell you what it was like? Can they show you any photographs? Was the uniform the same?

You could make a poster to show the similarities and differences between Yapton school now and then.

### Geography

What are the geographical features of Yapton? Is it a city, town or village? Does it have any factories, farms or shops? Why might people choose to live in Yapton?

Use Google Maps to explore Yapton from above and street level. Can you find our school?
