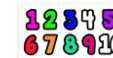


Toy Story by Disney Pixar

Science (Friday) – Properties of Materials

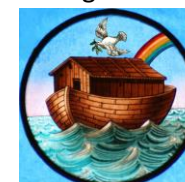
Do you know what a property of a material is? That's what we are learning about today!
