# THE UNIQUE YAPTON JOURNEY



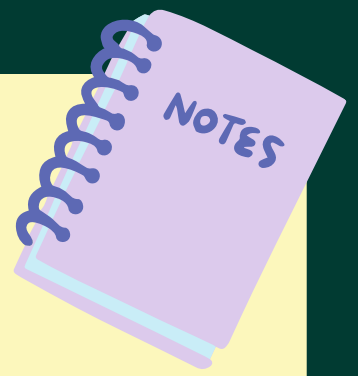
