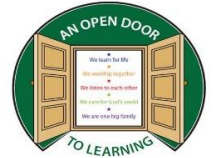

Kit List

Please use the following checklist to help pack bags:

- Sleeping bag & mat
- Small daysack (to carry lunches etc.)
- Refillable water bottle
- Pillow
- Outdoor footwear
- Tracksuit
- Waterproof jacket (and trousers if you have them)
- Two base layer t-shirts
- Fleece/warm tops
- Hat & gloves
- Training shoes
- Boots (if taking part in a rucksack carry activity)
- Old trainers (for water-based activities)
- Swimming kit
- Towel
- Wash kit (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, hairbrush, towels, hair bands, flannel)
- Underwear (pants and socks)
- Bin bag (to take dirty clothing home in)
- Pyjamas/nighties
- Slippers
- Torch
- Reading book
- Notebook and pen (optional)
- Any personal medication (in named container with instructions)

Notes

We recommend that students wear suitable clothing bearing in mind the layering system: base layer – thermals; mid layer – fleece top and trousers if required; outer layer – waterproof jacket, waterproof trousers, warm hat & gloves.

Footwear: we recommend 3 pairs:

- Pair of old sports shoes to get wet
- Pair of sports shoes for land activities
- Pair of walking boots for outdoor activities (sturdy trainers will suffice if you don't own a pair.

- ***If you have any questions or queries regarding this list, please ask your child's class teacher or Mr Hughes.***
- ***Please remember to pack enough clothes for the length of the visit.***
- ***The children may get wet more than once each day – especially if it rains.***
- ***It could get quite chilly at night!***
